1. Production Function and Specification

1.1 Function

TM Screen is a touch screen for the TM Robot S Series. Users can combine Robot Stick with the TM Screen into a teach pendant for an easier and better teaching experience while controlling the robot.

TM Screen comes with the following items in the package.

3. Installation

3.1 Host Board Installation

- 1. Make sure there is no power provided to the control box.
- 2. Open the robot control box.
- 3. Plug the host board into the slot shown below.
- 4. Secure the host board with the M3*L5 screw.
- 5. Plug the 8-pin connector onto the host board.





WARNING:

Users should be well-trained and make sure to comply with the following items:

- 1. Make sure the control box is correctly grounded (electrical grounding).
- 2. Make sure there is no power provided to the control box.
- 3. Make sure the installation direction of the board is correct.
- 4. Make sure the board is securely plugged-in and fastened.
- 5. Make sure there is no other touch from a metal material or disconnection of internal wirings mistakenly.

3.2 TM Screen Assembly

- 1. Loosen the TM Screen hand strap.
- 2. Plug the TM Screen in to the Robot Stick along its side tracks.



3. Rotate to tighten both thumb screws on the back of the TM Screen to make sure the module is fastened to the Robot Stick securely.

4. After assembly, six function buttons (Play, Pause, Stop, M/A, +, -) will show on the TM Screen UI. The homing bars on the bezel help users locate the function buttons without difficulty.



3.3 TM Pen Assembly

1. Twist the pen until it comes off as two pieces.



- 2. Put the tip end outwards and put both pieces together.
- 3. Twist to tighten the pen until it is firmly secured.
