



Ref.: Regulation N° 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization of Chemicals (REACH)

Dear Sir, Madam,

In answer to your inquiry, we hereby inform you about the impact of the REACH regulation (EU regulation N° 1907/2006 concerning the *Registration, Evaluation, Authorization of Chemicals*, hereinafter referred to as "REACH"), which entered into force on 1st June 2007, on products with the original Omron brand name.

We do not supply chemical products, substances on their own or preparations as defined by REACH.

We only supply finished products, which REACH refers to as "articles". However, there is no intended release of chemical substances from our products under normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, as defined by REACH.

Based on the above-mentioned reasons, we conclude that currently we do not have any obligations as a manufacturer or importer of chemical substances pursuant to REACH.

The candidate list of substances of very high concern (SVHC) has been published on the website of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) since 28th October 2008 and is updated regularly.

We are checking continuously whether substances included on the candidate list are contained in our articles or packaging materials in a concentration above 0.1 % (by weight). As far as substances, preparations and articles purchased by us are concerned, we are in contact with our suppliers to obtain the relevant information from them.

Depending on the result of our investigation and in accordance with REACH article 33(1) we will inform you automatically with every delivery, provided that we have information that substances included on the candidate list are contained in Omron products you purchase. Products containing SVHCs are individually indicated by a notice on the delivery note. Please visit "www.industrial.omron.eu/reach" for up to date SVHC information about these products.
